EXEMPTIONS

Exemption from CAN/CSA-B621-03, "Selection and Use of Highway Tanks, Portable Tanks, Cargo Compartments, and Containers for the Transportation of Dangerous Goods, Classes 3, 4, 5, 6.1, 8 and 9" for the movement of Petroleum Crude Oil, UN 1267, Packing Group I with a Reid Vapour Pressure not more than 25 psia.


CONDITIONS

1. The Petroleum Crude Oil is transported in a TC306 Crude, TC406 Crude, TC307, TC407, TC312, TC412 or TC331 type tank having a minimum MAWP of 28 psia.
2. The tank is designed, constructed and maintained according to the requirements of CSA B620-03.
3. A copy of this permit shall accompany each load and the driver shall be made aware of the permit location.
4. This permit exempts the permit holder from only those Part(s) or Section(s) of the Regulations identified above. To qualify for the exemptions shown, all permit conditions must be adhered to, and all remaining applicable provisions of the Act and Regulations, or other related legislation must be complied with.

5. If all conditions of this permit are not completely complied with, the permit holder shall totally comply with the Act and Regulations, and the permit shall no longer be applicable.
6. This permit is valid only in Alberta.
7. All those involved with handling, offering for transport, and transporting the dangerous goods identified shall be trained and certified in accordance with Part 6 of the Regulations.
