**EXEMPTIONS**

This permit is issued to current members of the above noted Permit Holder Association and exempts each such member as follows:

Exemption from Part 3 (Documentation) of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations, as adopted by the Dangerous Goods Transportation and Handling Regulation, for the road transportation of service and drilling rigs.

**CONDITIONS**

1. This permit is restricted to the road transportation of service and drilling rig equipment and supplies necessary for the operation, maintenance and safety of the employees and equipment.
2. This permit does not apply to dangerous goods included in Class 1, Class 2.3 and Class 7.
3. The dangerous goods shall be contained in small means of containment and the gross mass shall not exceed 500 kgs.
4. In addition to the 500 kgs allowed under Condition 3, this permit allows for the transport

of the following equipment and dangerous goods:

- UN 1002, AIR, COMPRESSED, CLASS 2.2 (maximum of 5 cylinders)
- UN 1774, FIRE EXTINGUISHERS CHARGES, CLASS 8
- UN 1044, FIRE EXTINGUISHERS, CLASS 2.2
- UN 1066, NITROGEN, COMPRESSED, CLASS 2.2, in nitrogen charged hydraulic accumulator bottles that are mounted fixtures on a blow-out preventer actuator unit.
- UN 1066, NITROGEN, COMPRESSED, CLASS 2.2, in cylinders that are maintained in standard and marked in accordance with Part 4 of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations and used in conjunction with blow-out preventers.
- LIMITED QUANTITIES of dangerous goods that conform to the quantities set out in Column 6 of Schedule 1 and the requirements of Section 1.17 (Limited Quantities) of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations up to a maximum of 150 kgs per transport unit.

5. This permit also allows for the transport of gasoline, fuel oil or propane in a large means of containment with a water capacity greater than 2,000 litres providing that these dangerous goods are accompanied by a shipping document (according to Section 3.5 of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations) showing:

- (a) the shipping name of the dangerous goods;
- (b) the capacity of the tank(s) when fully loaded;
- (c) an estimate of the quantity of dangerous goods remaining in the tank at the time of shipping.

6. Where the large means of containment referred to in Condition 5 contains UN 1202, fuel oil, and does not meet the requirements of Part 5 (Means of Containment) of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations, the large means of containment must be drained of all dangerous goods to the maximum extent that is possible and shall not contain more than 10% of the volumetric capacity of dangerous goods up to a maximum of 2000 litres when in transport.

7. The means of containment shall display safety marks in accordance with Part 4 of the Regulations.
8. A copy of this permit shall accompany each load and the driver shall be made aware of the permit location.
9. This permit exempts the permit holder from only those Part(s) or Section(s) of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations identified above. To qualify for the exemptions shown, all permit conditions must be adhered to and all remaining applicable provisions of the Act and Regulations and other related legislation must be complied with.
10. If the conditions of this permit are not met, the permit holder shall be in full compliance with the Act and Regulations and the permit shall no longer be applicable.
11. This permit is valid only in Alberta.
12. All those involved with the handling, offering for transport, and transporting the dangerous goods shall be trained and certified in accordance with Part 6 (Training) of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations.
