Introduction

EnCana Corporation is developing the Deep Panuke natural gas project in Nova Scotia's offshore. The project involves the installation of the facilities required to produce natural gas from the Deep Panuke field, located approximately 175 kilometres offshore Nova Scotia. Natural gas from Deep Panuke will be processed offshore and transported, via subsea pipeline, to Goldboro, Nova Scotia for further transport to market via the Maritimes & Northeast Pipeline.

EnCana is a leading North American unconventional natural gas and integrated oil company. EnCana common shares trade on the Toronto and New York stock exchanges under the symbol ECA. For more information on EnCana, see www.encana.com.

Project Quick Facts

- The project was approved for development by EnCana's Board of Directors in October 2007.
- EnCana has entered into an agreement with Single Buoy Moorings Inc. (SBM) for the provision and operation of the Deep Panuke production field centre.
- The design capacity of the project is 300 MMcf/d of sales-quality gas.
- Regulatory applications for Deep Panuke were filed in 2006, with approvals granted in 2007.

Drilling / Re-entry / Recompletion Program

One new drill well will be completed for acid gas injection. Fluids may be captured for analysis.

The four production wells can be summarized as follows. They were previously drilled with jack-up rigs. The wells will be re-entered and will be equipped for subsea production by means of a mudline conversion to subsea wellhead equipment. The wells will be completed and all wells may be flow tested for varying periods and reservoir fluids will be captured for further analysis.

EnCana is seeking interested firms for the provision of Well Control Consulting Services which includes the following:

1. Training to take place both onshore and offshore on
 - a. Basic Well Control (Enform 1st Line or equivalent)
 - b. Advanced Well Control (Enform 2nd Line or equivalent)
 - c. International Well Control Forum (IWCF)
 - d. MudCap
 - e. Advanced Completion techniques
 - f. Annular Velocity Control (AVC) Drilling Techniques
2. Audits of Drilling Rig Contractor Well Control equipment
3. Audits of Company and Rig Contractor Well Control procedures
4. Preparation of Well Control Documentation, Stack-up drawings, Procedures, bridging documents
5. Consulting during well control incidents
6. Hardcopy and electronic reporting

Any contract resulting from this EOI is expected to be awarded in June 2009. The work would commence in June / July 2009 and is estimated to be six months in duration.

Project Requirements

1. Interested parties are required to have a formal Quality Management System (QMS); a current certificate issued by a recognized third party that certifies that the QMS meets the requirements of ISO 9001.
2. All work carried out on the Deep Panuke Project shall comply fully with Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board Regulations.
3. Contractors shall have previous experience and solid Quality and EHS management performance on similar offshore projects.
4. Offshore personnel will be required to have valid Basic Survival Training acceptable to the CNSOPB and a valid H₂S certificate.

Information Requested with EOI response

Respondents must submit a brief Company profile, contact details, list of key personnel, resumes, and a summary of related experience including local Nova Scotia capabilities and all data pertinent to the scope of supply.

EnCana will select qualified bidders using the responses to this EOI as a guide. Any eventual list of Bidders will be posted on the EnCana website and other industry websites such as BIDS Nova Scotia. EnCana reserves the right to select more than one Contractor to execute the above Scope of Work.

EnCana is under no obligation to proceed with a Request for Proposal as a result of this call for Expressions of Interest. Respondents that qualify will be invited to participate in the event Proposals are solicited.
