DEEP PANUKE PROJECT SUMMARY

EnCana Corporation is developing the Deep Panuke natural gas project in Nova Scotia's offshore. The project involves the installation of the facilities required to produce natural gas from the Deep Panuke field, located about 175 kilometres offshore Nova Scotia. Produced gas will be transported by subsea pipeline to Goldboro, N.S., where it will be transported via the Maritimes & Northeast Pipeline (M&NP) to markets in Eastern Canada and the northeastern United States. First gas from the project is expected in 2010.

PROJECT QUICK FACTS

- The project was approved for development by EnCana's Board of Directors in October 2007.
- EnCana has entered into an agreement with Single Buoy Moorings Inc. (SBM) for the provision and operation of the Deep Panuke production field centre.
- The design capacity of the project is 300 MMcf/d of sales-quality gas.
- Regulatory applications for Deep Panuke were filed in 2006, with approvals granted in 2007.

EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

EnCana is seeking interested firms for the provision of Analytical Services associated with Scale Inhibition, including injection locations and product selection.

The analytical services are to address the following

- Review historical scale studies;
- Identify where scale starts to precipitate in the well, flowline, or topsides to determine injection locations;
- Recommend a methanol compatible scale inhibitor to be injected;
- Consider a scale inhibitor capable of accommodating a variance in the water analysis which will be re-evaluated when actual produced water samples are available;
- Provide procedures for injection of recommended scale inhibitor including safety and environmental data;
- Identify material compatibility concerns based on injection location;

- Evaluation of scale inhibitor injection location versus well fluid properties
- Determine volumes of scale inhibitor required.

EOI respondents are asked to provide company name, contact details, managers and key personnel, company profile, and a detailed summary of related offshore project experience. The company profile must identify any implemented Quality Management Systems, number of employees, union affiliations and long term contractual commitments.

EnCana will select qualified bidders using the responses to this EOI as a guide.

Expressions of Interest must be received on or before December 14, 2007, 1:00 pm Halifax time.
