Deep Panuke Project Summary

EnCana Corporation is developing the Deep Panuke natural gas project in Nova Scotia's offshore. The project involves the installation of the facilities required to produce natural gas from the Deep Panuke field, located approximately 175 kilometres offshore Nova Scotia. Produced gas will be transported by subsea pipeline to Goldboro, N.S., where it will be transported via the Maritimes & Northeast Pipeline (M&NP) to markets in Eastern Canada and the northeastern United States. First gas from the project is expected in 2010.

Project Quick Facts

- The project was approved for development by EnCana's Board of Directors in October 2007.
- EnCana has entered into an agreement with Single Buoy Moorings Inc. (SBM) for the provision and operation of the Deep Panuke production field centre.
- The design capacity of the project is 300 MMcf/d of sales-quality gas.
- Regulatory applications for Deep Panuke were filed in 2006, with approvals granted in 2007.
- Processed gas will be transported to the Maritimes & Northeast Pipeline through 175 kilometres of 22" pipeline.

Expression of Interest

EnCana is seeking interested firms for the development of an Operational Procedure for Pipeline Inspection Services (Intelligent Pigging) for the Deep Panuke Gas Export Pipeline (GEP).

Contractor shall be required to:

1. Review the design and operational characteristics of the Deep Panuke Pig Launcher, Pig Receiver, GEP, and associated valves, piping and controls to verify suitability with process stream characteristics, pipeline materials and design and for pipeline inspection through intelligent pigging, as well as identify any areas of concern or items which might affect the efficacy of the pigging run or data collection.
2. Review the handling, lay-down and work area requirements at the PFC and onshore facilities to determine suitability for launch and receipt of intelligent pigs and the use of associated equipment and services.
3. Assess the suite of pipeline inspection tools currently available and identify those suitable for use with the Deep Panuke GEP system to minimize impact on gas export production.
4. Produce a Pipeline Inspection Operational Procedure detailing all aspects of the intelligent pigging operation from transport of the equipment from the shorebase to the PFC through loading, launching, receipt and verification of data from the intelligent pigging run.
5. As part of the Operational Procedure, produce a sequential checklist of actions to be performed by the Operators responsible for loading, launching, receiving and unloading the intelligent pig which includes safety and environmental practices, procedures and parameters.
6. Provide a description of the additional services required to support the pipeline inspection program.

Project Requirements

1. Interested parties are required to have a registered Quality Management System and a current certificate issued by a recognized third party that certifies that the Quality Management System meets the requirements of the ISO 9001.
2. All work carried out on the Deep Panuke Project shall comply fully with Canada-Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board Regulations.
3. Contractors shall have previous experience with the application and development of Pipeline Integrity Management programs on similar projects.
4. Contractors shall be familiar with applicable pipeline codes and standards and shall demonstrate an understanding of applicable CNSOPB and NEB requirements for Pipeline Integrity Management systems.

Information Requested with EOI Response

Respondents must submit the following information as part of their EOI submission:

- A brief Company profile;
- contact details;
- list of key personnel and resumes proposed to execute the work;
- summary of previous experiences with the application and development of pipeline integrity management systems; and
- copy of ISO 9001 certificate.

EnCana will select qualified bidders using the responses to this EOI as a guide. Any eventual list of Bidders will be posted on BIDS Nova Scotia's website. EnCana reserves the right to select more than one Contractor to execute the above Scope of Work.

EnCana is under no obligation to proceed with a Request for Proposal as a result of this call for Expressions of Interest. Respondents that qualify will be invited to participate in the event Proposals are solicited.
