INTRODUCTION

EnCana Corporation is developing the Deep Panuke natural gas project in Nova Scotia's offshore. The project involves the installation of the facilities required to produce natural gas from the Deep Panuke field, located approximately 175 kilometres offshore Nova Scotia. Produced gas will be transported by subsea pipeline to Goldboro, N.S., where it will be transported via the Maritimes & Northeast Pipeline (M&NP) to market. First gas from the project is expected in 2010.

EnCana is a leading North American unconventional natural gas and integrated oil company. EnCana common shares trade on the Toronto and New York stock exchanges under the symbol ECA. For more information on EnCana, see www.encana.com.

PROJECT QUICK FACTS

- The project was approved for development by EnCana's Board of Directors in October 2007.
- EnCana has entered into an agreement with Single Buoy Moorings Inc. (SBM) for the provision and operation of the Deep Panuke production field centre.
- The design capacity of the project is 300 MMcf/d of sales-quality gas.
- Regulatory applications for Deep Panuke were filed in 2006, with approvals granted in 2007.

BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES

EnCana is committed to providing opportunities for Nova Scotian and Canadian companies through employment, procurement and contracting on an internationally competitive basis, with full and fair opportunity for Nova Scotians and Canadians, and first consideration to Nova Scotians where competitive on a best value basis. Companies who have been invited to tender will be required to complete a Canada-Nova Scotia Benefits Questionnaire, and demonstrate their commitment to and compliance with EnCana's requirements regarding Canada-Nova Scotia Benefits, during the tender process.

Interested firms are requested to demonstrate their capabilities and experience via a formal response to this EOI.

SCOPE OF WORK

EnCana Corporation seeks qualified, experienced contractors to provide services for construction and commissioning of the facilities associated with the onshore section of the 22-inch gas export pipeline.

The onshore pipeline is a 564.4mm OD x 17.5mm API-5L-X56 pipe with a 17.5mm Wall thickness and an upstream design pressure of 15300kPag (2219 psig), extending from landfall

to the M&NP pipeline tie-in location, located in the Goldboro Industrial Park. The pipe will be coated with Fusion Bonded Epoxy and is approximately 3 km in length. Facilities include the installation of a beach block valve station and the EnCana pipeline terminus directly adjacent to the M&NP metering facility:

The scope of work is summarized generally as follows:

- Receipt and handling of free-issue materials including the long lead valves, 22-inch above ground pipe, telecommunication and satellite equipment, ICSS equipment, and 22x16 inch bar-t.
- Procurement and receipt of all other temporary and permanent equipment and materials not identified within the request for proposal.
- Installation of all above ground valves and above ground piping.
- Installation and commissioning of all instrumentation and controls.
- Finish grading of the beach valve and Terminus sites.
- Construction of bases and pedestals required for the telecommunication tower and satellite dishes.
- Installation of fencing and facility lighting and security measures.
- Fabrication and installation of the MCC building at the terminus.
- Installation of on-site electrical power and underground connection to NSPI supplied tie-in location at both the beach valve station and terminus locations.
- Supply of all consumables, including but not limited to: welding consumables, coating consumables, on-site construction power, site offices, craneage, temporary lighting and all other services required to complete the scope of work.
- Provision of construction security measures

The pipeline onshore facilities shall be designed and constructed in accordance with the CSA Z662 and the National Energy Board (NEB) Onshore Pipeline Regulations, and is subject to inspection and approval by a Certifying Authority, the NEB, and EnCana Corporation.

Interested parties must include provision of all necessary personnel and equipment to complete the entire scope of work.

It is anticipated that the Work will be awarded in March of 2009.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

EOI respondents are required to have an implemented Quality Management System that is certified in accordance with the requirement of the ISO-9001 series of Standards and Safety Management Systems(s). Respondents are also notified that the Work carried out on the Deep Panuke Project shall comply fully with NEB and CSA Z662 requirements.

Respondents must be qualified and demonstrate that they have suitable resources, processes, capability and capacity to complete the scope of work. They must also be able to demonstrate previous experience on similar projects.

Interested firms are asked to demonstrate their capabilities and experience via a formal response to this Expression of Interest and the Prequalification Questionnaire, which can be obtained from BIDS Nova Scotia at the address provided below.

In accordance with the commitments made by EnCana, priority will be given to companies who can demonstrate the capability to complete the scope of work in Nova Scotia on a competitive basis, meeting or exceeding EnCana's requirements for safety, quality, technical suitability, reliability, delivery and environmental standards. Pre-qualified companies will be required to complete a Canada-Nova Scotia Benefits questionnaire, and demonstrate their commitment to and compliance with EnCana's requirements regarding Canada-Nova Scotia Benefits, during the tender process.

INFORMATION REQUESTED WITH EOI RESPONSE

Respondents must submit a brief Company profile, contact details, key personnel and a summary of related experience including local Nova Scotia capabilities and all data pertinent to the scope of supply.

EnCana will select qualified bidders using the responses to this EOI as a guide. Any eventual list of Bidders will be posted on the EnCana website and other industry websites such as BIDS Nova Scotia. EnCana reserves the right to select more than one Contractor to execute the above Scope of Work.

EnCana is under no obligation to proceed with a Request for Proposal as a result of this call for Expressions of Interest. Respondents that qualify will be invited to participate in the event Proposals are solicited.
