Introduction

Encana Corporation is developing the Deep Panuke natural gas project in Nova Scotia's offshore. The project involves the installation of the facilities required to produce natural gas from the Deep Panuke field, located approximately 175 kilometres offshore Nova Scotia. Produced gas will be transported by subsea pipeline to Goldboro, N.S., where it will be transported via the Maritimes & Northeast Pipeline (M&NP) to market. First gas from the project is expected in 2010.

Encana is committed to providing opportunities for Nova Scotian and Canadian companies through employment, procurement and contracting on an internationally competitive basis, with full and fair opportunity for Nova Scotians and Canadians, and first consideration to Nova Scotians where competitive on a best value basis. Companies who have been invited to tender will be required to complete a Canada-Nova Scotia Benefits Questionnaire, and demonstrate their commitment to and compliance with Encana's requirements regarding Canada-Nova Scotia Benefits, during the tender process.

Scope of Work

Encana Corporation seeks qualified, experienced fabrication companies for the provision of labour, materials and equipment to remove seafastened equipment onboard the Rowan Gorilla III drilling rig (RGIII) under the direction and supervision of company.

It is expected that this work will be completed in Halifax Harbour over the period of approximately one week in late October / early November 2010.

The scope of work includes the removal of seafastenings, foundations and supports on the RGIII deck and reinstatement of deck surfaces to original condition including surface coatings of the following equipment:

- ROV Spread
- Vetco Gray / Claxton Sub-sea Christmas Tree Test Stump Deck Connection
- Vetco Gray Workover Control System (IWOCS) Spread
- Knuckle – Boom Crane IWOCS deployment system
- Expro Well Testing Spread, including overboard vent lines
- Flare Boom Pedestal and foundations
- Sabre Supplied Air Equipment
- Weatherford Mudlogging equipment
- Schlumberger Wireline Unit

- Pad Eye removal (Tensioning Support) located beneath Rotary Table.
- Assist with the removal of redundant power supply cabling and associated communication cables.

The scope includes the provision of all certified welding personnel and supervisors to meet demobilization schedule. In addition to providing welders, respondents to this EOI will be required to supply painters, NDT inspectors, electricians, scaffolders, raw materials, welding materials and consumables, paint and scaffolding and scissor jacks.

Submission Requirements

Respondents are advised that the Work carried out on the Deep Panuke Project shall comply fully with Canada Nova Scotia Offshore Petroleum Board Regulations. Respondents must have a significant working knowledge and experience in working within an effective permit to work system and associated work procedures and practices.

EOI respondents are required to have an implemented Quality Management System that complies with the requirements of the ISO-9000 series of Standards (or equivalent) and Safety Management System(s).

Submissions should include details regarding offshore experience and capabilities, manpower available with American Bureau of Shipping (ABS) or Canadian Welding Bureau (CWB) certification and supervisory experience.

Encana will select qualified bidders using the responses to this EOI as a guide. Any eventual list of Bidders will be posted on the Encana website and other industry websites such as BIDS Nova Scotia. Encana reserves the right to select more than one Contractor to execute the above Scope of Work.

Encana is under no obligation to proceed with a Request for Proposal as a result of this call for Expression of Interest. Respondents that qualify will be invited to participate in the event proposals are solicited.
