GENERAL

EnCana Corporation is proposing to develop its Deep Panuke gas prospect located offshore Nova Scotia. The Project Field Center which contains all of the main facilities, will be located approximately 250 km southeast of Halifax, approximately 47 km west of Sable Island and in 44 metres water depth. Producing wells will be subsea completions delivering sour gas to the Field Center via buried subsea flowlines. Trees will be connected to the Field Center with a dedicated umbilical to each subsea tree.

The Deep Panuke Project will generate important activity and provide significant opportunities within Nova Scotia and Canada. In recognition of this, EnCana Corporation is committed to using and encouraging capable and competitive Nova Scotian and Canadian companies for the provision of the high quality goods and services required in these activities.

Development of the project is subject to EnCana Corporate sanction.

EnCana is seeking interested firms for the provision of Project Management and Engineering Support Services for activities associated with progressing the Subsea infrastructure for the period up to First Gas (planned for Q4 2010).

It is anticipated that the selected contractor will provide personnel to work as integrated members of the EnCana Project Team to provide in house management and technical support in Halifax Nova Scotia, as well as coordinate any technical support activities which may be required by the contractor's home office staff. Work will commence in Q4 2007.

The project management and engineering support may involve the following:

- Provision of senior subsea project/package manager to lead the EPIC subsea flowline and umbilical package. (Halifax based position)
- Provision of senior subsea controls engineer to provide technical assistance on the subsea trees and controls package (Halifax based position)
- Provision of senior subsea tree engineer to provide technical assistance on the subsea trees and controls package (Halifax based position as necessary)
- Provision of technical expertise to carry out detailed flow assurance studies for steady state, start up, shutdown and transient conditions for the subsea gathering lines using OLGAs or other similar flow assurance software (work to be performed by Contractor's home office staff). As a part of the flow assurance work, final insulation thicknesses and hydrate management strategies are to be determined.
- Provision of other engineering and technical support related to subsea flowlines, umbilicals, and trees, as requested.

EOI respondents must indicate company name, contact details, managers and key personnel, company profile, and provide EnCana with a detailed summary of related offshore project experience. The company profile must identify any implemented Quality Management Systems, number of employees, union affiliations and long term contractual commitments.

EnCana will select qualified bidders using the responses to this EOI as a guide.

Expressions of Interest must be received on or before November 6, 2007, 1:00 pm Atlantic time.
